Bonhoffer's Seven Principles to Eradicate Selfish Ambition*:

- To hold our tongues and refuse to speak anything unkind against a brother or sister in Jesus.
- Cultivate the humility that comes from understanding that we, like Paul, are the greatest of sinners and can only live in God's sight by His grace.
- Listen "long and patiently" so that we will understand their fellow Christian's need
- Refuse to consider our time and calling so valuable that we cannot be interrupted to help with unexpected needs, no matter how small or menial.
- Bear the burden of their brothers and sisters in the Lord, both by preserving their freedom and by forgiving their sinful abuse of that freedom.
- Declare God's Word to our fellow believers when they need to hear it.
- Understand that Christian authority is characterized by service and does not call attention to the person who performs the service.

Mere Christianity by C. S. Lewis :

- Pretend that we are Jesus and look at life as if we were Christ.
- How would we approach conflict with a brother or sister in the church?
- How would Jesus use His time and resources?
- How would He approach this conversation, and what might He say or not say? How would He listen and speak?
